The Seattle Architecture Foundation is committed to providing a professional, friendly, safe, and welcoming environment for all participants at its programs. Though we can't meet in person, we hope to achieve a high level of interaction in our webinars via Zoom. Together we can create a productive and safe environment to listen, learn, and share ideas. To this end, all attendees and speakers are required to agree with the following code of conduct. SAF will enforce this code throughout the event.

SAF is dedicated to providing a harassment-free online webinar experience for everyone, regardless of gender, gender identity and expression, age, sexual orientation, disability, physical appearance, body size, race, ethnicity, religion (or lack thereof), or technology choices. We do not tolerate harassment of webinar participants in any form. Webinar participants violating these rules may be sanctioned or expelled from the webinar at the discretion of the organizers.

Harassment includes, but is not limited to:

- Verbal comments that reinforce social structures of domination related to gender, gender identity and expression, sexual orientation, disability, physical appearance, body size, race, age, religion, or technology choices.
- Deliberate intimidation.
- Harassing photography or recording.
- Sustained disruption of talks or other events.
- Unwelcome sexual attention.
- Advocating for, or encouraging, any of the above behavior.
- Participants asked to stop any harassing behavior are expected to comply immediately.

If a participant engages in harassing behavior, the workshop organizers may take any action they deem appropriate, including warning the offender or expulsion from the webinar.
